And while we've always considered ourselves Essential knowing what an important role our programs play in the lives of ArtHouse kids who have no access to the arts, we were approached by one of our long-time friends; Henderson Partners LLP with an offer to help us launch a campaign to provide ArtHouse families with fresh meals, support some of our local restaurants and continue to offer our Arts Programming but in a new “virtual” world.

A Covid-19 pivot for sure, but the outcomes have enriched so many:

OUR WORK TO JULY 24-2020:

- 1,650 Freshly Prepared Meals delivered to 66 families (260 Individuals) in Oakville and Burlington
- 4 Restaurant Providers - Kerr Street Café – Seasons – Ritorno – The Platter Company
 - Wellington Square United Church
- 25 Volunteers completing the SAFE Delivery of these meals to our ArtHouse families
- 23 On-line Educational You-tube Programs reaching hundreds of kids
- Zoom Interactive Arts and Drama Programming simultaneously reaching 50 kids from 9 different locations
- \$177,500 Raised:
 - \$110,000 from 200 Donors and \$67,500 through Federal Government Grants
