FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY:

1. ArtHouse provides information on Compensation that matches the requirement of CRA in the T3010 Return:

ArtHouse had 4 Full-Time Employees during its Fiscal Year ended June 30-2022:

- 1 Employee received compensation between \$1 and \$39,999;
- 2 Employees received compensation between \$40,000 and \$79,999;
- 1 Employee received compensation between \$80,000 and \$119,999.
- 2. Remuneration of Directors:
